

# Familiarize yourself with the rule book:


**SECTION 1.—Positions and Equipment of Players**

**ART. 1 . . . IN BASEBALL, EACH TEAM** is permitted nine terms (7 in regulation high school game) at bat during which it attempts to score runs by having its batters become base-runners who advance to and touch first base, second base, third base and then home base. The team in the field attempts to end each term at bat of the opponent by causing three of their batters or base-runners to be out. Each of the two teams consists of 9 players, one of whom must be designated captain. He and the coach represent the team in communications with umpires. The captain's duties include: providing the umpire-in-chief with the name, shirt number, position and batting order of each starting player; and informing all players as to special ground rules as announced by the umpire-in-chief.

**ART. 2 . . . A PLAYER IS DESIGNATED** in the score book by name, shirt number and by his fielding position. A customary arrangement of the fielders is shown by the diagram.

**ART. 3 . . . AT THE TIME OF THE PITCH,** all fielders shall be on fair ground except the catcher who shall be in the catcher's box.

**ART. 4 . . . A PLAYER** may change to a different fielding position at any time except that a pitcher, after being announced, cannot


- QSP delegated inspector
